You May be Protected Under the McKinney-Vento Act!

Children and youth in temporary housing have the right to:

- stay in the same school even if you move
- receive transportation
- enroll in school immediately without documents
- receive free school meals
- get help with school supplies and other needs
- get extra support for youth who are on their own
- get early childhood services
